

## REGISTRATION POLICY

### Approved Education Programs

---

#### Introduction

One of the ways to meet the registration requirements for a certificate of registration as a registered intern optician or a registered optician is to complete an opticianry program that is approved by the Registration Committee or by an accrediting body approved by the Registration Committee.

Program approval ensures that applicants are prepared to practise opticianry safely, competently and ethically and is in line with the College of Opticians of Ontario's (the College) mandate to protect the public.

Graduates of an approved program are considered to have met the education requirement for registration with the College.
