# OPPORTUNITIES TO WORK WITH US!

## **Appointed Committee Members**

Although they do not have voting privileges at Council, Appointed Members play an active role in the College's public protection mandate by serving on committees. Committees make policy recommendations to Council as well as decisions on matters including Registration, Quality Assurance and Discipline.

## **Peer and Practice Assessors**

Peer and Practice Assessors conduct on-site and remote practice assessments of the knowledge, skill and judgement of selected Registered opticians. Assessors produce a comprehensive, objective report of the optician's practice for the consideration of the Quality Assurance Committee.

## **Examiners for the NACOR Examinations**

An examiner observes the performance of exam candidates in a practical station and records their observations on standardized test sheets, which are scored by NACOR.

## **Models**

The College recruits models for contact lens and eye glass fitting portions of the exam. Being a Registered Optician is an asset for this role.
