2.0 Emergency Class of Registration

The Board reviewed draft amendments to O. Reg. 869/93 (Registration) under the *Opticianry Act, 1991*. The proposed amendments will create an emergency class of registration in accordance with the requirements under O. Reg. 508/22 under the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*. The proposed amendments were circulated to stakeholders for a period of 60 days.

The board reviewed the draft amendments and stakeholder feedback. The Registration Committee recommended approval of the draft amendments as presented, noting that no major concerns were identified by stakeholders.

Public interest considerations: The board considered that the purpose of the emergency class is to facilitate access to opticianry services in the event of a public emergency. The proposed amendments to the Registration Regulation will achieve this objective by creating an expedited path to reinstatement for opticians who have been out of practice for fewer than six years. The proposed amendments will also protect the public by striking a balance between the need for opticians on an emergency basis and ensuring that opticians will practise safely and in accordance with the Standards of Practice.

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion considerations: The board considered that the proposed amendments strike a balance between the need for facilitating access to opticianry services in the event of a public emergency and ensuring that opticians will practise safely and in accordance with the Standards of Practice. The board did not identify any concerns from a diversity, equity or inclusion perspective with respect to the proposed amendments.
