Board Elections:

Terms for Districts 1 (Paul Imola), 5 (Golta Mohammadi) and 8 (Carlos Pacheco) are expiring at the end of December 2026. Elections for these seats fall under the new, One-District elections model. Nominations opened April 23rd and closed on May 22nd. Interest was high and we are pleased to have received a record 8 applicants for the positions. Elections will be opening on September 10th, closing September 24th. The top three candidates with the highest votes will fill the three board openings.

Registrant Support:

The College regularly hosts support webinars for our registrants to assist with understanding updated legislation and policies. The College held a New Registrant webinar on September 10th.

Considering recent developments with the Ontario Opticians Association suspending services, the College has been in touch with the OOA regarding continuing education and professional liability insurance (PLI) offered by them. PLI has been confirmed to be in effect until year end. There are some concerns with gaps in coverage between year-end and the 2027 renewal deadline on January 15th. There are also concerns with registrants receiving proof of attendance certificates. The College has sent out a e-blast to our registrants to bring this to their attention and to urge proactivity in these matters.

Public Appointments and Staff Updates:

We are pleased to announce that the Minister's office has appointed Rose Cavaliere and reappointed current board member, Omar Farouk to our Board of Directors. Congratulations to both.

After the departure of Ms. Raj Bhatti, Ms. Tertia van Jaarsveld is now Interim Director of the Professional Conduct Department. Ms. Caitlin Hase will be joining the team as a Coordinator on a contractual basis as we finalize the staffing in this department.

External Relations:

We are finalizing our Fall external event dates. Our in-person events tied to the OOA that included Toronto, Ottawa, London and Sudbury are likely not moving forward. The team is connecting with other CE providers to explore participation in live webinars as well as hosting our own events to deliver College Updates. On top of our New Registrant Webinar, we are planning to host webinars on:

Members of the staff team will be attending the CNAR regulatory symposium being held in Montreal on October 5th and 6th. The NACOR Administrator's National Meeting will follow October 7th.

Administrative Projects:

The administrative team has been working on various internal projects over the summer. Improvements in the way of automations of accounting processes has been underway to streamline our annual audit, improve efficiency and accuracy of financial posting and speeding up processing times. Efforts are underway to improve the user experience for board and appointed members expense submissions as well.

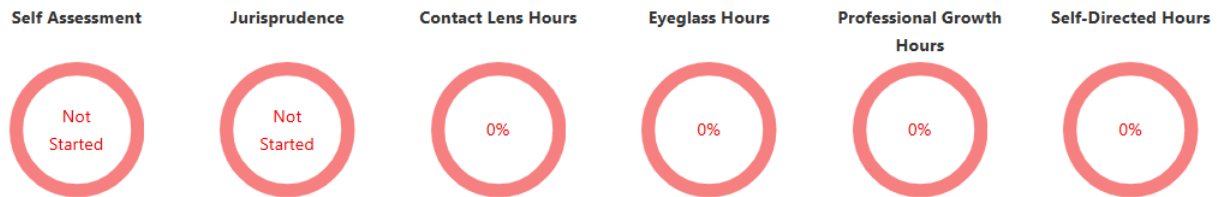
